Literacy:

Literacy this week concentrated on repetition of sentences in traditional tales. We looked at stories such as Rapunzel, Three Little Pigs, The Little Red Hen and other stories where characters say the same thing on more than one occasion to create a repetitive effect. The children also spent time learning the 'll'sound in words.



Science

The children have been learning about what happens when light cannot travel through an object and so creates a shadow. We learned how the sun makes shadows and how to change the shape of our shadows using our bodies, hands and feet. We will be making shadow puppets soon and putting on a show.

P.E.

The children have been investigating the different ways they can travel around the hall. They have been rolling, sliding, stepping and turning their bodies.



Maths:

The children spent the week asking each other questions about things they like to do, eat and play and turning the information gathered into tables and lists.

They spent some time finding the difference between two objects and numbers.



Design and Technology: We designed cavemen using pieces of fabric for their clothes and made spears out of sticks. We used wool to make strands of hair and put them onto a wall display in class.
