We have started to look at non-fiction information books. We chose animals and created questions about them, then we found our answers in the appropriate books. We practiced using alphabetical order so we could use the index!



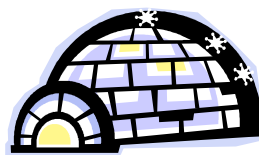
Maths:
