We have also been learning about money in preparation for week 5's MATHS WEEK challenge!

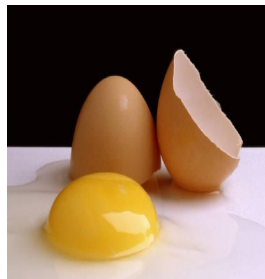


French, Y2

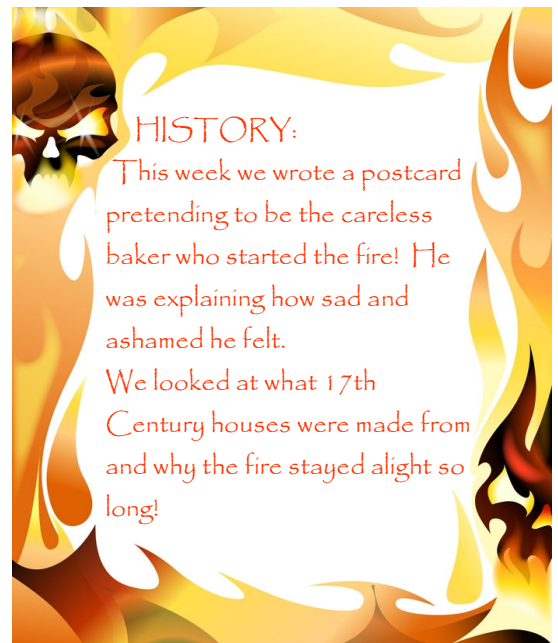
