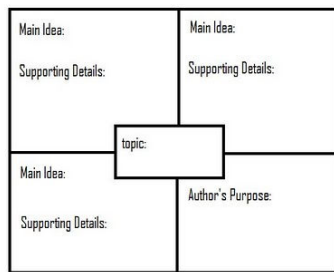
2D: Reach for writing a perfect piece of non-fiction writing using the 4-square

2J: Chakri for trying hard to complete all his work correctly.



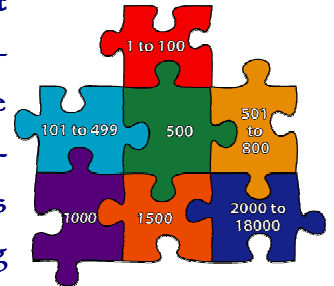
LITERACY:
