We are really looking forward to doing lots of measuring for Maths Week.

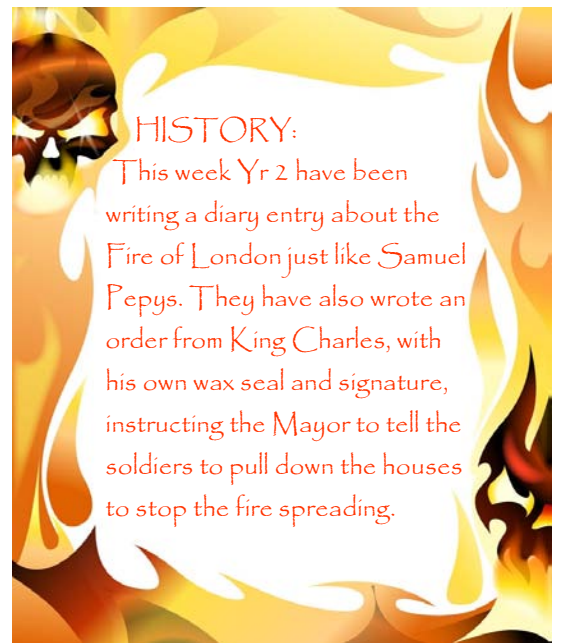
### SCIENCE
