**Maths Fayre - Friday 2.15 - 3.15** a traditional fayre with games to play and stuff to buy - guess the weight to win the cake etc!

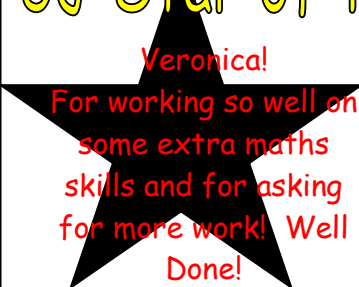
