- You can find optional Numeracy homework outside the Year 5 classrooms, which focuses on the topic of study for that week; please help yourself!

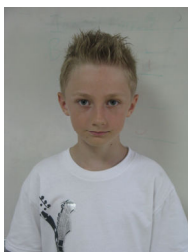
Star of the Week 50
