

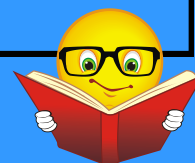


Learning Highlights

Curriculum Focus Science

In Science year 7 and 8 have been learning about **Simple Chemical Reactions**

They have learnt that:

- Bubbles in a liquid show the presence of a gas. Fizz in the coke is due to the Carbon dioxide.
- Oxygen supports burning.
- Hydrocarbon fuels contain a large amount of Carbon in them and when they burn in the lack of oxygen. A poisonous gas- carbon monoxide is made.
